Think Spring!

Start composting at home for a healthy yard and garden!

Why Compost at Home?

- Enriches the soil and enhances crops or gardens
- Yard waste is relatively clean and decays easily into soil
- Reduces the need for water, fertilizers and pesticides in your garden.

The Earth Machine composter is available in our office for \$50, which includes a Wingdigger aerator and a helpful composting booklet.

If you prefer to put yard and garden waste in your brown lidded yard debris cart, please follow these restrictions:

- Cut items to 3 feet or shorter and less than 4 inches thick
- Include leaves, prunings and grass
- The lid must close
- No plastic bags
- No lumber
- No food waste, animal waste or garbage

What Plastics Can I Recycle?

Almost every plastic item has the recycle triangle on the bottom, but they are not all recycled here. Different plastics are made of slightly different materials, so they do not all melt together in the recycling process. Also, the plastic recycling industry is relatively new and not as developed as other industries.

In recycle cart or at depot

Bottleneck plastics are accepted in your grey lidded recycling cart and at our recycling depot at 2904 Wynooski Rd, Newberg. This means that the neck is smaller than the base. Examples include milk jugs, water bottles and detergent bottles. Please remove the lids and rinse or scrape the bottles.

What do I do with other plastics?

Currently, no other plastics, including styrofoam, are accepted in your recycle cart or at the recycle depot. If you want to recycle them, please call our office for a list of locations that accept them. Otherwise, you may put them in your garbage can.
